The Western NE Human Resources Management Association will award one \$1,000 scholarship to a student currently attending or entering an accredited secondary institution. It is not required that the applicant study Human Resource Management, however a student interested in entering the Human Resource Management field may be given preference.

An applicant must:

- Be a resident of Scotts Bluff, Banner, Morrill, Box Butte, Cheyenne, Dawes or Sioux Counties in Nebraska or Goshen County, Wyoming.
- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average. [Send a copy of your school transcript.](#)
- Register for a minimum of 12 semester credits.
- **Major in Human Resource Management, Accounting, Business Administration, Business Management, Finance, or Economics.**
- Provide two letters of reference with name, relationship, business, and business address included.
- Submit a typed letter stating:
 1. Traditional or non-traditional student.
 2. Career goals.
 3. Civic involvement and activities, i.e.: church, school, community.
 4. Personal biography including your hobbies.
 5. Name and location of college you plan to attend.
 6. Tuition costs.
 7. A statement regarding your need for a scholarship.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the college upon notice of enrollment. **This information must be completed in full for the application to be considered----PLEASE PRINT.**
